



EPB GENERAL POWER RATE – SCHEDULE GSAC

Availability

This rate shall apply to the firm power requirements (where a customer's contract demand is greater than 50 kW but no more than 1,000 kW) for electric service to commercial, industrial, and governmental customers, and to institutional customers including, without limitation, churches, clubs, fraternities, orphanages, nursing homes, rooming or boarding houses, and like customers.

Character of Service

Alternating current, single- or three-phase, 60 hertz. Power shall be delivered at a service voltage available in the vicinity or agreed to by Distributor.

Base Charges

Adjustment

The base demand and energy charges shall be increased or decreased in accordance with the current Adjustment Addendum published by TVA.

Determination of Demand

Distributor shall meter the demands in kW of all customers served on this rate schedule. The metered demand for any month shall be the highest average during any 30-consecutive-minute period of the month. Excess demand shall be the amount of metered demand in kW which exceeds the contract demand. The billing demand shall be the contract demand plus the excess demand except that the billing demand for any month shall in no case be less than the greater of the contract demand or 30 percent of the highest billing demand established during the preceding 12 months.



Minimum Bill

The monthly bill under this rate schedule shall not be less the sum of (a) the base customer charge, (b) the demand charge, as adjusted, applied the customer's billing demand and (c) the base energy charge, as adjusted, applied to the customer's energy takings.

Distributor may require minimum bills, payable in advance, monthly, or otherwise, higher than those stated above. Distributor may require additional charges to provide recovery of costs for customer-specific distribution facilities.

Contract Requirement

Customers who request and receive service under this rate schedule shall determine a contract demand in kW and be required to execute contracts for an initial term of at least 1 year. The contract demand shall be determined by (a) the customer's highest billing demand established during the preceding 12 months or (b) the customer's estimate of demand if the customer's demand will differ from the highest billing demand established during the preceding 12 months or if the customer does not have a 12-month history of demand. Distributor shall not be obligated to supply power in a greater amount at any time than the customer's currently effective contract demand. If the customer uses any power other than that supplied by the Distributor under this rate schedule, the contract may include other special provisions. The rate schedule in any power contract shall be subject to adjustment, modification, change, or replacement from time to time as provided under the power contract.

After having received service for at least 1 year under this rate schedule, the customer, subject to appropriate amendments to its power contract with Distributor, may modify their contract demand under this rate schedule or receive service under the General Power Rate Schedule GSA.

Payment

Bills under this rate schedule will be rendered monthly. Any amount of the bill that is unpaid after the due date specified on bill may be subject to additional charges under Distributor's standard policy.

Single-Point Delivery

The charges under this rate schedule are based upon the supply of service through a single delivery and metering point, and at a single voltage. If service is supplied to the same customer through more than one point of delivery or at different voltages, the supply of service at each delivery and metering point and at each different voltage shall be separately metered and billed.

Service is subject to Rules and Regulations of Distributor.
